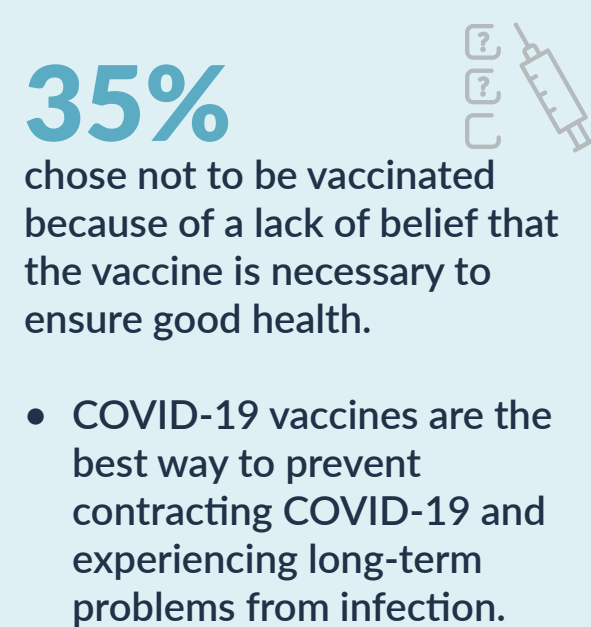
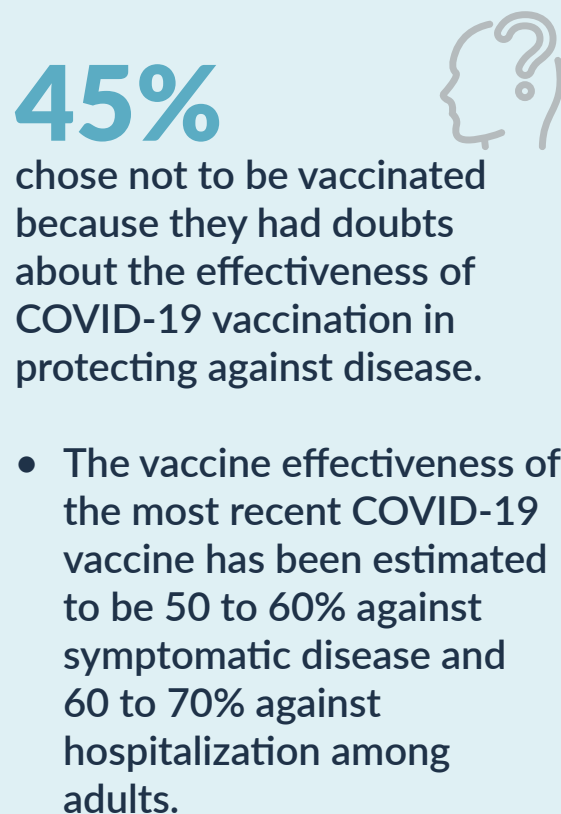
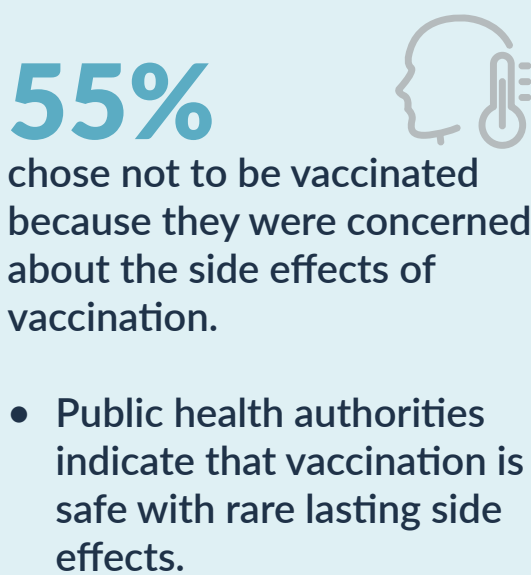


Why Are People Getting Vaccinated
